
- (1) find and determine that the petition filed herein by the Board of County Commissioners of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, does comply with the requirements of Chapter 6119 of the Revised Code of Ohio as to form and content;
- (2) fix May 16, 1972, at 1:30 P.M. in Courtroom No. 11 of the Cuyahoga County, Ohio Court House as the time and place for a final hearing of the said Petition for the establishment of the proposed Regional Sewer District;
- (3) order that the Clerk of the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court give notice of the said time and place of the said final hearing on the said Petition by publication once each week for four consecutive weeks in a newspaper having a general circulation in Cuyahoga County, Ohio in accordance with the provisions of 6119.04, specifying that any person or any political subdivision residing or lying within the area affected by the organization of the said Cleveland Regional Sewer District, on or before the time and date set for the said hearing thereon, may file an objection to the granting of the requests or a request made in the prayer of the Petition.



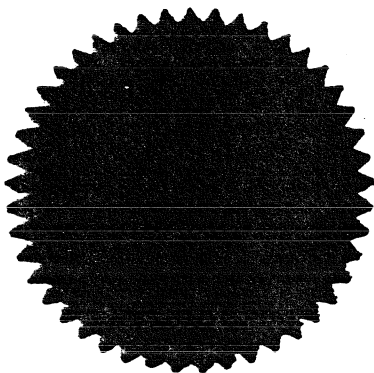

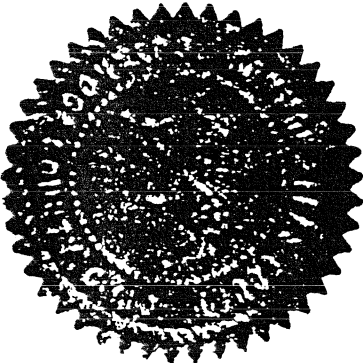

Cleveland Metropolitan Sewer District.
To All Persons and Political Subdivi-
sions

Public Notice is Hereby Given:

That on the 15th day of April, 1972,
pursuant to Chapter 6119, Ohio Re-
vised Code, there was filed in the of-
fice of the Clerk of Court of Common
Pleas of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, the
petition of the Board of County Com-
missioners of Cuyahoga County, Ohio,
for the establishment of a Sewer Dis-
trict to be known as The Cleveland
Regional Sewer District.

The petition states that the estab-
lishment of a metropolitan sewer dis-
trict under the provisions of Chapter
6119 of the Ohio Revised Code is nec-
essary and the establishment of said
district will be conducive to the public
health, safety, convenience and wel-
fare.

The purpose and ultimate goal of
the District shall be the establishment
of a total waste water control system
for the collection, treatment and dis-
posal of waste within and without the
District.

1. Serving the metropolitan Cleve-
land area;

2. With uniform metropolitan rates;

3. With control, administration and
financing by a Board of Trustees;

4. Capable of being expanded in the
future to include additional areas;

5. With overall control of all waste
water collection systems in the area
through rules and regulations for the
purpose of obtaining uniform con-
struction and inspection of facilities
and for the purpose of regulating dis-
charges into the system, but with local
sewage collection facilities under lo-
cal jurisdiction for planning, construc-
tion, financing and maintenance pur-
poses unless the local municipality de-
sires to contract with the District for
such services; according to a plan spe-
cified in the petition.

The territory to be included in the
Cleveland Metropolitan Regional Sew-
er District shall include in whole or
in part the following political subdivi-
sions:

Pri Beachwood, City of (all)

Brenton, Village of (all)

Brecksville, City of (all)

Am Broadview Heights, City of (all) ex-
cept that portion located south of
the Ohio Turnpike)

Brook Park, City of (only that por-
tion north of Five Points Road be-
tween the Berea Freeway and In-
terstate Route 71; north of Holland
South Road; and north of the south-
city corporation line between Smith
Road and West 139th Street)

Re Brooklyn, City of (all)

Brooklyn Heights, Village of (all)

Cleveland, City of (all except that por-
tion in the extreme northeast part of
the City which is served by sewers
connected to the Euclid Wastewater
Treatment Plant and except that
portion in the western part of the
City which is served by sewers con-
nected to the Lakewood Wastewater
Treatment Plant)

Cleveland Heights, City of (all)

Cuyahoga Heights, Village of (all)

East Cleveland, City of (all)

Euclid, City of (only that portion in
the western part of the City served
by sewers connected to the Cleve-
land Easterly Wastewater Treatment
Plant)
