



PRESENTED BY THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT

- WATER SUPPLY** First, our region's water supply is pumped directly from Lake Erie to the Cleveland Division of Water's water treatment plants.
- CLEAN WATER** Next, the City of Cleveland pumps the clean water to our homes (and businesses).
- HOMES & BUSINESSES** From our homes we wash clothes and dishes, bathe, flush the toilet, and wash our cars with the clean water.
- WASTEWATER** After the water is used, it is considered wastewater. From the pipes, the wastewater travels to sewers, which transport the water to wastewater treatment plants.
- TREATMENT PLANTS** Once the District treats and cleans the wastewater, the clean water is transported back into the Cuyahoga River and Lake Erie, reentering our water supply.
