



Reporting Spills

- Gasoline spills
 - Call your local fire department immediately, then call the District at one of the numbers listed below
- Oil or Chemical Spills
 - Call the District at one of the numbers listed below

Reporting Odors

If you notice sewage or chemical odors in your home or workplace, follow these instructions:

- Sewage odors – Add water to dry traps and floor drains. If odors continue, contact your local service department
- Chemical odors
 - Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., call the District's Water Quality and Industrial Surveillance Department at (216) 641-6000
 - After hours and on weekends and holidays, call (216) 641-3200
