Oil-based paint (No latex)

Shellacs

Wood Stains

Mercury (Must be sealed in a plastic bag or container)

Varnish

Paint Thinner & Spray Paint

Pesticides, Insecticides, & Herbicides

Motor Oil

Roof Tar

Sealers & Primers

Flourescent Bulbs

Polyurethanes

Household Cleaners

(Oven & Drain)
